

# INVESTMENT OPTION – PENSION

## Super Growth



### Investment Objectives/Target Return

To achieve high returns over the longer term. Earnings should exceed inflation by at least 5% averaged over greater than 5 year periods. (CPI + 5%). The probability of a negative return for this option is 1 in 4.7 years.

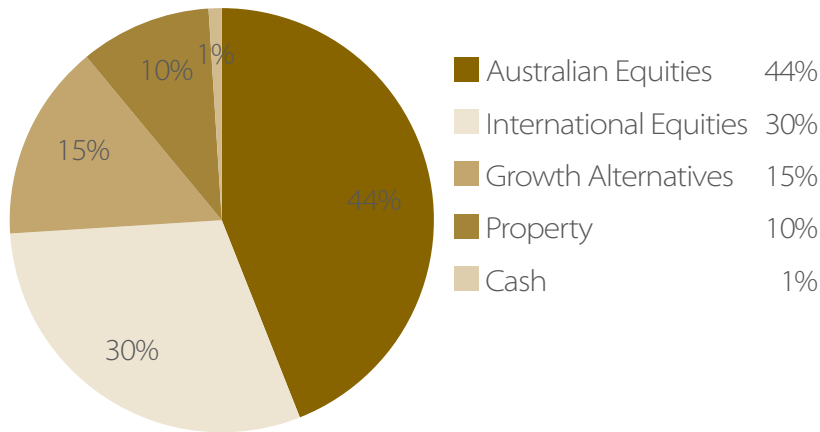
### Investment Risk

This option has more volatility than the Balanced option and is designed to produce higher returns over the long run. However the increased volatility is also likely to produce the occasional negative return.
